Our policy is to not utilize our confidential relationships with our clients for any purpose, even in attempting to tell the agency's story to our various publics.

FrontLine Service does not disclose client names, images, stories depicting identifying information, medical status, or any individually specific information on any of our clients—either in agency publications or media communications.
